The route shall be to metropolitan Adelaide (along the most appropriate roads) to pick up and set down passengers. Passengers must be deemed eligible by the coordinators of the Murray Mallee Community Passenger Network Coordinator. Bookings will be made by the coordinator to ensure passengers are eligible and medical appointment times are made between 11am and 2pm.

The minimum number of services that are to be provided between the Murray Mallee regions (originating from towns outlined in Table 1) to medical facilities in Murray Bridge, Mount Barker, Stirling and metropolitan Adelaide is one return service per weekday. Services will not operate on weekends or public holidays and does not operate for four (4) weeks over the Christmas/January period (dates to be negotiated between the Contractor and the Public Transport Services Division).

The services are to be scheduled to enable passengers to travel to metropolitan Adelaide for specialist medical appointments.

Passenger bookings are managed by the Murray Mallee Community Passenger Network then forwarded to the contractor for coordination of journey planning.

Southern Yorke Peninsula Contract, currently operated by Yorke Peninsula Coaches

The Yorke Peninsula Community Passenger Network provides a booking service for services in the Southern Yorke Peninsula contract.

- **Yorke Peninsula Medical Service**

The Special (Medical) Service operates every weekday (Monday to Friday). The Special (Medical) Service is a door-to-door pre-booked service available on demand by prior arrangement for people with disabilities or impaired mobility to attend medical services in Adelaide.

Appointments and pick-up/drop-off times will be coordinated through the Yorke Peninsula Community Passenger Network. The service will operate according to the bookings received by the Yorke Peninsula Community Passenger Network.

The timetable is dependent on the number of passengers and their pick up locations. The Service is to arrive in Adelaide prior to 10.30 am and depart after 14.30 pm in order to allow passengers enough time to attend their medical appointments.

The Special (Medical) Service does not operate on public holidays and for 2 weeks (approximately 10 working days) over the Christmas/New Year period (dates to be negotiated between the contractor and DPTI).

Passengers are to be picked up from towns in the Southern Yorke Peninsula and Copper Coast.

- **Service 5 – Medical Service from Port Augusta and Port Pirie Regions to Metropolitan Adelaide**

This service is for residents of the Upper North areas to attend medical/specialist appointments in the Adelaide metropolitan area.

The service operates every Tuesday (excluding public holidays and for 2 weeks over the Christmas/New Year period*). Trips are booked by the Northern Passenger Transport Network and are forwarded to the Contractor every Friday. The Contractor schedules the passenger pick up and drop off schedule/times and advises the passengers prior to travel.

Departure from Port Augusta is normally at 5.30am with the earliest medical/specialist appointment to be no earlier than 10.30am in Adelaide. The latest medical/specialist appointment in Adelaide should be no later than 2.00pm, with the expected departure from Adelaide at 2.30pm, arriving back in Port Augusta at 7.30pm.

[Special Medical Service in the Clare Valley and Intertown/Intratown Clare Valley Services Contract, currently operated by Yorke Peninsula Coaches](#)

The Mid North Community Passenger Network provides a booking service for services in the Clare Valley Medical Service and Intratown/Intertown Clare Valley services contract.

- **Service No. 1 Special (Medical) Service**

The Special (Medical) Service operates every weekday, except Thursday. The Special (Medical) Service is a door-to-door pre-booked service available on demand by prior arrangement for people with disabilities or impaired mobility to attend medical services in Adelaide.

Appointments and pick-up/drop off times will be coordinated through the Mid North Community Passenger Network. The service will operate according to the bookings received by the Mid North Community Passenger Network.

The timetable is dependent on the number of passengers and their pick up locations. The services are to arrive in Adelaide prior to 10.30am and depart after 2.30 pm in order to allow passengers enough time to attend their medical appointments.

The minimum number of services that are to be provided between Clare and surrounding towns, and medical facilities in Metropolitan Adelaide is one return service per weekday (excluding Thursdays, public holidays and days where no passengers have been booked on the service). This requires provision of a minimum of one service from the Clare Valley region to metropolitan Adelaide in the morning and an afternoon (return) service from metropolitan Adelaide to the Clare Valley region.

The Special (Medical) services does not operate on public holidays and for 4 weeks (approximately 20 working days) over the Christmas /New Year period (dates to be negotiated between the Contractor and the Ministers Representative each year).

- **Services 2, 2A, 3, 3A and 3B**

These services will operate on Thursdays and are designed to provide a regular and accessible passenger transport service linking surrounding towns with Clare and providing a demand responsive service allowing travel within Clare and Burra between designated times.

Passengers must book onto these services in advance. Booking passengers onto the service will be the responsibility of the Mid North Community Passenger Network Coordinator. This information will be forwarded to the Contractor the afternoon of the preceding business day.

Services 2 & 3 do not operate on public holidays and for 4 weeks (approximately 20 working days) over the Christmas/New Year period (dates to be negotiated between the contractor and the Ministers Representative each year).

- **Service No. 2A – Clare Intratown (operates in conjunction with Service 2)**

Provides demand responsive service within the town of Clare between 11:00am and 2:00pm every 1st and 3rd Thursday.
